INITIATIVE PETITIONS

Constitutional Amendment 2

Legalizes sports gambling, regulated by Missouri Gaming Commission. Tax proceeds would go to schools and gambling addiction programs.

Constitutional Amendment 3

Establishes an individual right to reproductive healthcare, including abortions and contraceptives. Prohibits the government from punishing individuals who provide or assist in reproductive healthcare.

Constitutional Amendment 5

Allows a new casino to operate at Lake of the Ozarks. Tax proceeds would go to early-childhood literacy programs in public schools.

Constitutional Amendment 6

Imposes a fee on criminal court cases to fund salaries and benefits for current and former sheriffs, prosecuting attorneys, and circuit attorneys.

Constitutional Amendment 7

1) Emphasizes that only citizens of the U.S. are allowed to vote (a requirement already established by state law.) **(2)** Bans ranked-choice voting. **(3)** Requires that a person who receives the most votes in a political party primary is the only person allowed as a candidate for their party in the following general election.

Proposition A - Raises the state minimum wage to \$15 per hour by 2026. Requires inflation-based adjustments to minimum wage starting in 2027. Requires employers to provide paid sick leave. Public entities such as governments and school districts, are exempt from this amendment.
